Find out what goes in and what doesn't



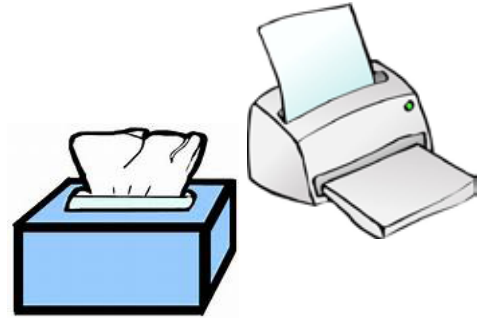

Recycle in every room



Recycling isn't just for the kitchen. Place recycling bins in other areas of the house such as offices, bedrooms and bathrooms, to capture items like paper, cosmetics containers, toilet paper rolls etc.



Shop smart

Choose products that are made with recycled materials and that are easier and less costly to recycle. For example, polystyrene and multi-layered plastic containers are at least 7 times more expensive to recycle than cardboard packaging.
